Slaves to be divided Derry, Will, Nan, Levi, Leah, Southy & Sall

To Rachel Taylor widow of William for her dower ... Will

To William Taylor, who is pay to his sister Betsey five pounds and to his John five pounds ... Derry

To Euphamy, who is to pay her sister Betsey nine pounds eight shillings & eleven pence ... Nan

To Peggy ... Leah

To Wilson ... Southy

To John and to receive from his brother William five pounds ... Sall

To Betsey and to receive from her brother William five pounds and from her sister Euphamy nine pounds eight shillings and eleven pence ... Levi

Given under our hands this fifth day of June Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and ninety two
