This Indenture made this Twenty fourth day of  
July. - in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred  
and ninety nine. Between Edward Winston of the  
County of Hanover of the one part, and John Geddis Winston of the  
same County of the other part; Witnesseth, that <sup>whereby as</sup> the said Edward  
Winston is, and stands justly, indebted to the said John Geddis  
Winston in the sum of One hundred and twenty five pounds  
money of Virginia, with legal interest thereon from September  
~~last~~ till it shall be paid, and payable on the first day of  
March that shall be in the year One thousand eight hundred,  
and the said Edward Winston being willing and desirous effe-  
ctually to receive to the said John Geddis Winston his Heirs  
Executors Administrators or assigns the payment of the aforesaid  
sum with the interest thereon as aforesaid, and for and in  
Consideration of the sum of One Dollar by the said John Geddis  
Winston at and before the unsealing and delivery of these presents  
the said Edward Winston in hand paid, the Receipt whereof is  
hereby acknowledged; Hath granted bargained sold aliened enfe-  
offed and confirmed, and by these presents doth clearly and  
absolutely grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm, unto  
the said John Geddis Winston and to his Heirs and assigns, the  
following named negroes to wit, Pegg & Child. Patience  
Rose and Mariah,

with the future increase of the fee males. To have and  
to hold the aforesaid negroes with the future increase of the  
fee males aforesaid, to him the said John Geddis Winston his Heirs  
and assigns, to the only use benefit and behoof of him the said  
John Geddis Winston his Heirs and assigns forever. And the said  
Edward Winston the said negroes with their increase aforesaid  
against himself his Heirs and assigns, and against the claim of  
all other persons whatsoever to the said John Geddis Winston his

Heirs and assigns by these presents shall and will warrant and  
forever defend. Nevertheless that if the said Edward  
Winston his Heirs Executors Administrators or assigns shall well  
and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said John Geddes Winston  
his Heirs Executors Administrators or assigns the aforesaid sum of  
one hundred and seventy five pounds with the legal interest  
that may become due thereon, that then this indenture and  
every thing herein contained shall cease determine and be  
void. In Witness whereof the said Edward Winston hath here-  
unto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year first  
above written.
